Staffing changes and new starts (pupils) settling in.

- ➤ 11 new staff, 3 probationer teachers, 2 fixed term, 6 permanent
- Running vacancy for PE October target.
- ➤ Modern Languages & Design-Tech vacancy
- Science understaffing but as per allocation
- Recruiting for acting DH: in support of move to 8 Nat5's over 2 years
- New Pupils: 240 S1s settling in well from all staff.
- Clair Stanton DH oversaw transitions from Primary. 36 new pupils to S2/S3 2
 new classes tackling 'in-zone waiting list'
- ➤ 1275 total roll.

Activities week

- ➤ Planning underway format similar to last session.
- > S1 local, S2 residential UK, S3 wider option home/abroad.
- Extra curricular program launching: sports captains advertising in assembly, new clubs.

Preliminary exam results/attainment data

- Raw data from SQA. Nat5 4th year 90% passing. Highers results also strong get #'s. 6 year high.
- National performance managed reduction to baseline so positive results for Cults not seeing as much negative adjustment.
- Updates when full dataset shared and reviewed w/Faculty heads

	Q: will there be parental involvement in these schemes? A: yes will be engagement and potentially feed into a sub group engagement

	Q: Is there an opportunity for careers engagement improvement? A: SIP content, bring in professionals to learn about careers from practitioners – several at a time. Lets use parents/PC and broader - Action to consider how to tap parents as a resource?	Action: RA
	Q: Is there a similar opportunity for improvement in engagement w/Uni (Aberdeen uni parent).	
	A: CA has an RGU staff member – in school rep that organises events. There is a school coordinator.	
	Q: Do students have to sign up to get engaged? A: Events are advertised through assemblies/bulletins and is present at a location in the school on given days	
	Q: Has the breadth of subject choices expanded? A: Yes the options have expanded – increase to 8 over 2yrs. Also new courses on science, photography. Increased uptake on Music & arts	Action RA
	Q: Is there an alternative to school jumper? Hoodie option? Pupil engagement for future? A: Not immediately as guidance just presented. Will be considered. National guidance also to be issued shortly. Consideration of climate vs clothing requirements (summer heat – collar/tie/blazer requirement)	
	Q: S1s to be given chromebooks? A: Devices are not available uniformally. Faculty heads responsible for distribution of allotted machines based on learning	
3	Mobile phone use policy Policy: young people are allowed to bring them into school. Not to be insight in lessons unless	
	directed by teacher. No phones around key areas, changing rooms, exams, no images/photos	
	w/out consent. Policy to be reviewed/updated in the future.	
	School is not reliant on pupil mobile phones for comms and pupils will not be excluded.	

4	School capacity / Pupil Teacher ratio Few years ago an 18% capacity increase was introduced. Roll forecast wrong – 'hit capacity in 5 yrs time' facilitates in appropriate planning assuming greater capacity than reality. Fed into Aberdeen City Parent Council forum. Capacity 1350 – so roughly 50 off. Pupil/Teacher ratio query. Aberdeen vs National Action – pass on dataset from Robert Brew.	Action BS
