
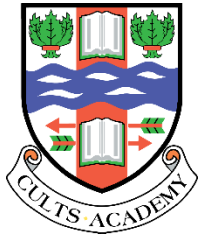

The Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF) has 12 levels. Here are some of the qualifications we offer at Cults Academy.

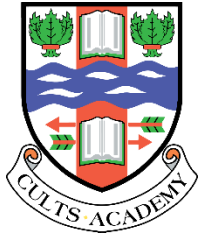

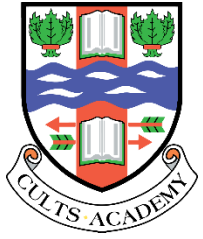
- Colleges will accept a range of qualifications including Highers, Nationals, NPAs, SFW and Foundation Apprenticeships

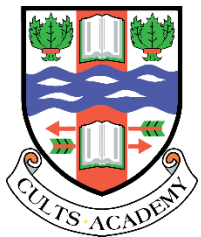

# S6 Timetable

- In most cases pupils study a minimum of 4 subjects. The only exception is for those studying 3 Advanced Higher courses.
- The expectation is that pupils complete the courses that they start.
- ‘Crash’ Highers are an options for learners. They must have demonstrated attainment at Higher in a comparable subject

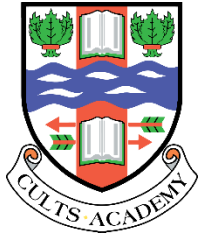

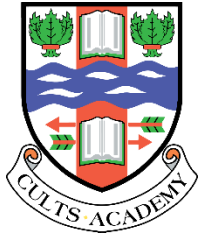

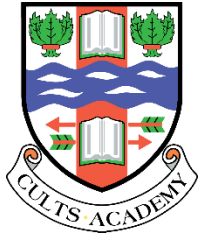

- Foundation Apprenticeships can be studied at NESCol, partnering schools (ABZ Campus) or at Cults Academy.

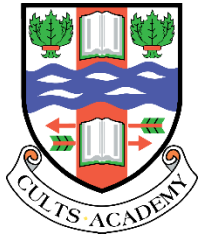

# When to take Advanced Highers

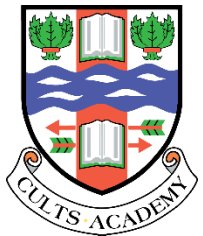

We would recommend that, where possible, learners are on track to achieve the entry requirements fully by the end of S5 if they are considering taking Advanced Highers.

## Why?

- Most universities/courses will not ‘double count’ a Higher and Advanced Higher in the same subject. This can vary by university and course.
- Even if one of your options does double count, your options may be limited as a result.

**If in doubt contact the admission office of each university you are applying to**

Advanced Highers will not improve chances of getting an offer. Offers given will likely related to S6 Higher performance. However, Advanced Higher workload will be considerable.



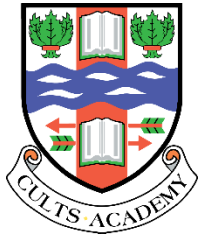


# Things to think about when choosing subjects

**Step 1:** Look at the subject choice forms to see which courses are available

**Step 2:** Use the Pathway Planning website to research courses and entry requirements.

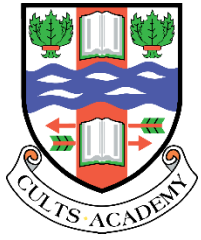
Do the same for College/University/Employment options.

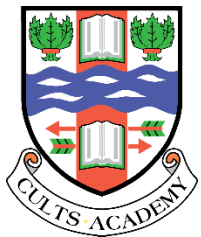

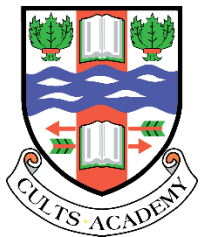
