Aberdeen Inspired is once again working with ADHD Foundation on the Umbrella Project. The project aims to raise awareness and celebration of the 'umbrella' term of neurodiversity, which includes ADHD, autism, dyslexia, dysgraphia, dyspraxia and Tourette's Syndrome.
